The AVID Program is a 9th through 12th grade component of students' (who apply and get in) high school experience at Bound Brook. This stellar program prepares students for admission to a college/university education and careers beyond high school. As a part of the AVID Secondary System, students take an AVID Elective course throughout high school that provides them with the skills needed to be successful in advancing academically with the ultimate goal of attending college. For more than 30 years, AVID has been instrumental in preparing students for increased success in higher education and careers.

The core component for the AVID Secondary System is the AVID Elective, which supports students as they challenge themselves in classes that are more rigorous. Students are taught study skills, note taking, time management, writing skills, and research skills, while being immersed in a college-going culture. The class also includes tutoring sessions led by college students and provide support for success in the academically rigorous curriculum. Additionally, the AVID class provides access to information about colleges and universities through field trips, guest speakers, college tutors, college admission requirement information, and career planning.
