Bound Brook High School Alumni Association Scholarship Awards Guidelines and Instructions

Purpose: The purpose of the Bound Brook High Alumni Association Scholarship Awards is to provide financial assistance for a student who has made a positive contribution to a BBHS athletic team and for a student who has made a personal contribution towards the betterment of the Bound Brook or South Bound Brook communities with their involvement and/or volunteerism.

**Applicants may apply for both awards if they meet all eligibility requirements and complete the Specific Topic essays for both scholarships.

Eligibility Requirements: In order to be eligible for consideration, scholarship applicants must:

- Be graduating from Bound Brook High School at the end of current academic year.
- Plan to further their education at an accredited post-secondary institution.
- Be a U.S. citizen, or documented permanent resident of the U.S. Race, color, creed or sex will not be factors in choosing the Award winners.
- Recipients will be asked to provide proof of acceptance to their post-secondary school before receiving payment of the Award.

Application Submission Instructions: To be eligible for consideration, applications must:

- Be typed (preferred) or printed in blue or black ink on only one side of the page. Essays <u>must</u> be typewritten.
- Be clearly legible and submitted in English.
- Be completed in entirety with pages in same order as they were received.
- Be submitted in hard copy. Applications received by fax or email will NOT be accepted.
- Include current and accurate contact information. BBHS Alumni Association will contact you at the phone number, email address or physical address you provide.
- Provide all signatures where indicated on the application.

Application Timeline: Dates will be finalized when applications are distributed for 2023

January: Applications are available for students

- April 28: Completed applications and all supporting letters due.
- May 22- May 26: Candidates will be interviewed by Scholarship Committee
- **June:** All applicants will be notified of the results of the Scholarship committee. Only scholarship award winners will be notified by phone.

- 14. Name five to ten passions, what you love about life. Why did you pick the each of the ones you did?
- 15. Write down ten important things you have learned in the past four years
